

CHARGE MISSIONS

Beds from Christ 2022 Summary

It has been a gratifying year for the Beds From Christ mission; and we hope that the Medford United Methodist church parishioners feel the success. It is because of your generous contributions, as well as other Taylor County community members, that the program was able to successfully serve forty individuals in Taylor County at an average cost of \$363.60 per person. Our thanks to Jim Flood, Steve Mayer, Jerry Hubbard, and Herman Pernsteiner who delivered, and set up 34 beds: seven queen, eleven full, sixteen twin, and one toddler size bed. These beds were delivered in the Medford and Rib Lake area to persons ages four to approximately eighty. Other individuals needed partial assistance such as bedding or a frame for their existing mattress. Additionally, a private donation provided two twin size beds to fulfill a request from outside the county. Our Saviour's Lutheran Church's quilters have kept our quilt supply at an all-time high and we are grateful for their support of the program. All this could not have been possible without the presence of Perry Edblom from Better Buy who offers a discount on bed purchases and manages the supply of beds at his store.

In April, the Wisconsin United Methodist Foundation Inc. granted Beds from Christ \$800.00 to promote the program. With those funds, the Beds program created T-shirts, banners, and printed material in both English and Spanish. The printed materials were distributed to Human Services, Public Health, Law Enforcement, Hospice, Taylor House, The Commission on Ageing, Stepping Stones, and churches throughout the county. The program members were present to promote the program at the 2022 Medford Chair Affair and on radio station WKEB in November.

In December, 2022 the Weather Shield LITE Foundation granted the Beds program \$1,000. These funds will be designated for bed and bedding purchases. Also in December 2022, Beds from Christ successfully applied to the Aspirus Medford, Community Benefit Program and was awarded \$8,000. This money, when received, will provide an outstanding start to the anticipated budget of \$16,000 for 2023. The anticipated increase in budget is due to our successful promotion and the success of Taylor House - helping homeless individuals find homes in the community.

Thank you, thank you Medford United Methodist congregants for believing in this mission. Both your financial donations, and gently used linens are so very much appreciated and it is because of YOU that we are meeting needs for sleep in Taylor County.
