

### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

The Wisconsin Annual Conference was held on June 9-12 in Green Bay, Wisconsin.

On the first day of Conference, the matter of church disaffiliations was taken care of. There were 43 churches that were disaffiliating, ranging in size from 14 members to 937 members. After about an hour-and-a-half, those disaffiliations were approved.

The Conference closed five churches this year. Those churches were the Bashford United Methodist Church in Madison, The Wellspring United Methodist Church in Madison, the New Horizons United Methodist Church in Wittenberg, The Beetown United Methodist Church in Beetown, and the Summerfield United Methodist Church in Milwaukee.

The Wisconsin Conference has covenant affiliations with several health and welfare organizations in the state. This year, we renewed the covenant affiliations with Harbor House in Superior, Northcott Neighborhood House of Milwaukee and United Methodist Children's Services of Milwaukee.

A budget for the coming year was approved. The proposed budget is \$6,920,500, down from last year's budget of \$7,800,000. This budget covers the workings of the Annual Conference, including committees and commissions and the District Superintendents and the Bishop.

There were twenty-two clergy retirements this year and three ordinations.

We heard the Bishop's State of the Conference address, the address from the Dean of the Cabinet, our District Superintendent Tsuker Yang. There were reports from the Laity and the delegation to the upcoming General Conference in 2024. There were also elections from both the clergy and laity to fill holes in the delegation due to the several postponements of that General Conference.

This year's conference was a combination of hybrid (online) and on site attendance. It was announced that next year's conference will be totally on site, with no hybrid options. Those dates are June 7-10 in Green Bay.

Dennis Jones and I were your representatives to Annual Conference this year.

The 2023 Wisconsin Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church took place on June 9 - 12 in Green Bay. There were several items on the agenda including disaffiliation resolutions over issues of human sexuality. There were 43 churches in Wisconsin that met the requirements of disaffiliation and were voted on as a group. The property of these churches will remain with each disaffiliated church.

Members of these churches who did not vote for disaffiliation can remain with their church or can find another church to attend. There will be an effort to help those individuals who want to remain with the Wisconsin United Methodist Church.

There were a number of other items brought forward including a group of South Korean church members who reminded us that Korea is still a war zone. The war is still quite real to them. Korean hand fans were distributed at the conference to remind us of their sorrow. One of these fans has been attached to the bulletin board in the Fellowship Hall.
