### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God."
-- Matthew 5:9

Who are the peacemakers in this world?

I think of Jimmy Carter, in his 90s and currently living under hospice care. His presidency is considered by many to have been one of the worst in history. He served one term and was not reelected. There are many who have dug into his presidency, and I do not intend to do that here. However, I think that Jimmy Carter has had one of the best post-presidencies ever. Besides being instrumental in the formation of Habitat for Humanity, he traveled far and wide in attempts to promote peace. He even received the Nobel Peace Prize for his work toward peace.

Peace is not an easy thing to achieve. There always seems to be some war or dispute happening in the world. The movie "Oppenheimer" shows that even when war concludes, there are people and countries that are restless and not able to handle peace.

As Christians, I believe we are to promote peace the best we can. We are to promote peace through our words and our actions. We are never to say one thing and do another. In confirmation, I always have the confirmands start thinking of how to live the Christian life. We talk about Jesus saying "turn the other cheek". If I ask them what to do when someone slaps them, they ultimately say to slap back, using our human brains. They start thinking about what Jesus said, and some will say "give them your other cheek." Most will say things like find an adult to tell or walk away or ignore it. It is the beginning of peace making.

Being a peace maker is both hard and easy. It is hard to orient our lives to the concept of making peace. Once we do, it is easy to hold on to the concept and live it. My advice to students just starting school is to be the peace maker in your school.
